## Admission Process

Admissions to the Nursing programmes offered by Santosh College of Nursing, Santosh Deemed to be University, Ghaziabad, are governed by the applicable regulatory framework of the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and State Nursing Council. The programmes are affiliated to Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University (ABVMU), Lucknow, and admissions are conducted in accordance with the guidelines and notifications issued by ABVMU for the relevant academic year.

GNM program admission is based on **UPGM Entrance Test (UPGET) 2026** via Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University notified entrance test and counselling process.

B.Sc. Nursing program admission is based on **Common Nursing Entrance Test (CNET) 2026**, B.Sc. via Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University notified entrance test and counselling process.

M.Sc. Nursing programmes, candidates must possess the prescribed nursing qualification, valid registration, and required clinical experience as per INC and university guidelines. Admission is based on **Common Nursing Entrance Test (CNET) 2026**, M.Sc. via Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University notified entrance test and counselling process.

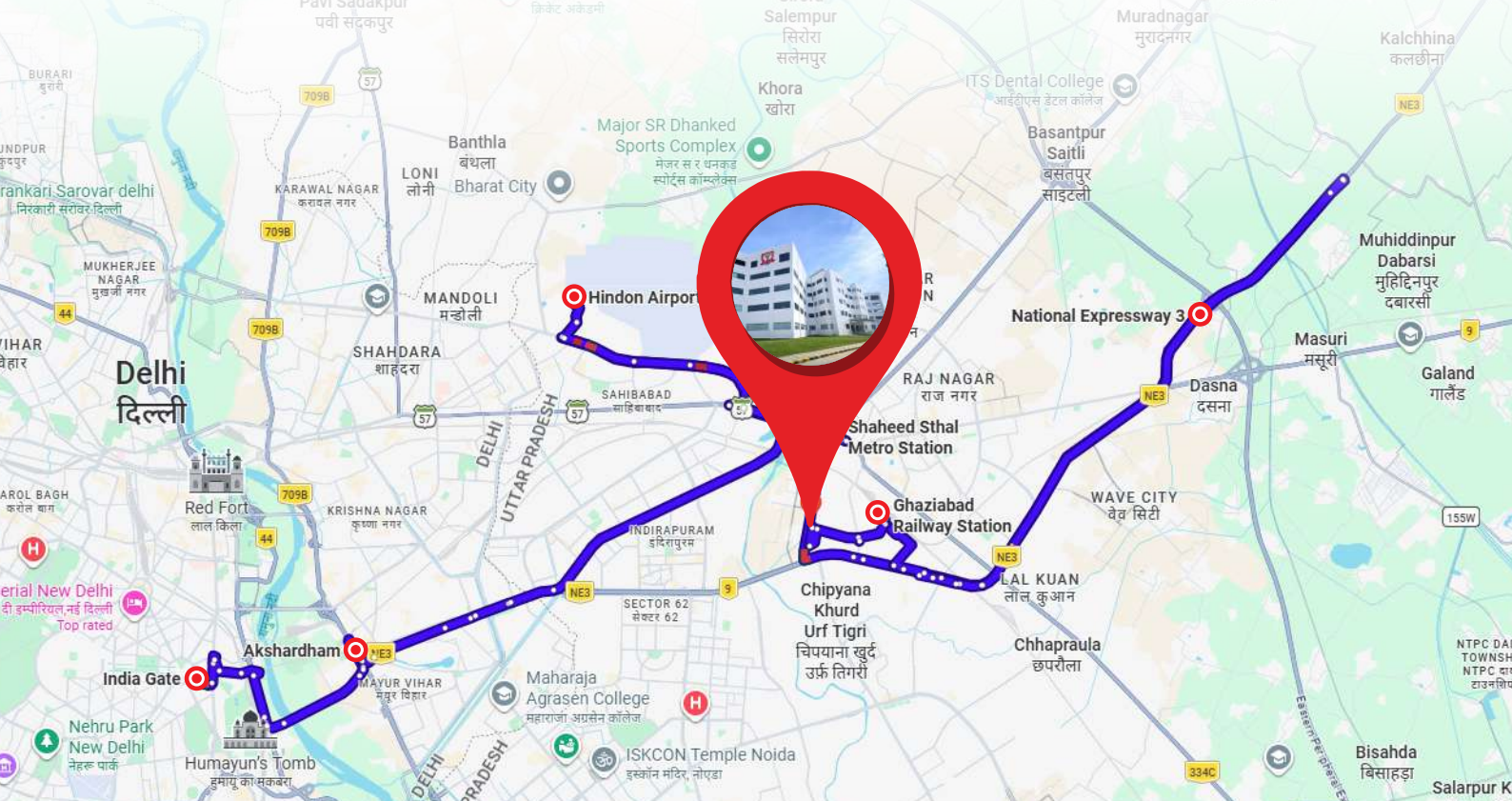
